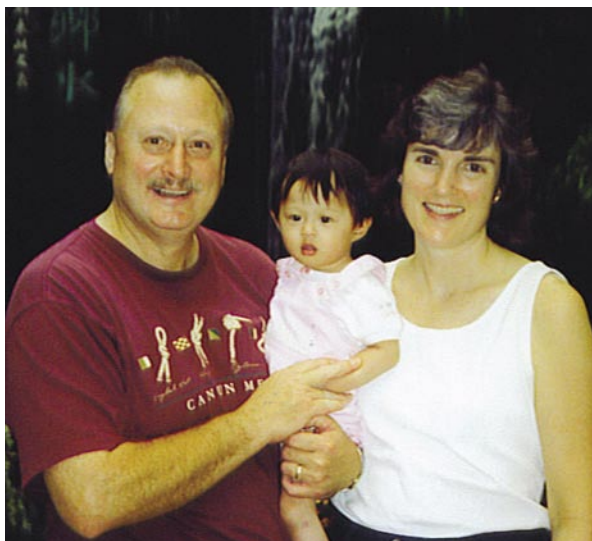

ADOPTION WORKS

- Most adoptions are successful!
- Adoptive parents do a great job learning to be parents.
- What would happen if families could have more information about their child's development and ways to maximize it?

WHAT IS PARTners?

- It is a parent-focused developmental intervention for adoptive families
- A program that builds on the strengths of adoptive families



WHAT DO FAMILIES PROVIDE?

- An agreement to weekly visits lasting up to 6 months
- Willingness to participate in assessment activities over a two year period
- An adopted child under the age of 5
- Willingness to come to the Mandel School (on the Case campus) at least once a month

WHAT SERVICES DO FAMILIES RECEIVE?

- Assessment of your child's development over time
- Techniques to enhance and increase the quality of your relationship with your child
- Trained early interventionist who provides weekly visits
- Post adoption support and referral to services (if needed)
- A stipend for completing each assessment period
